

Main Campbell

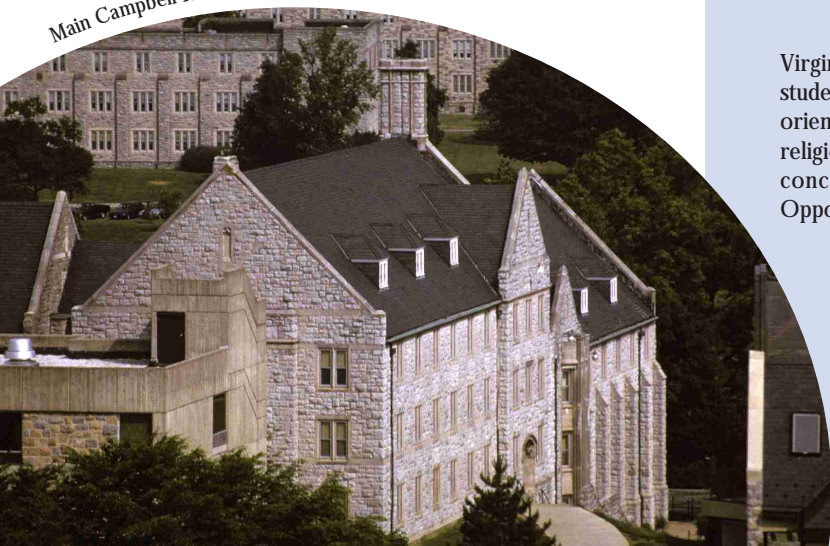
Located on the Drillfield next to the War Memorial Gym, Main Campbell offers an economical choice for graduate, professional, and selected undergraduate Honors Program students. Single- and double-occupancy rooms are available. Rooms include a twin bed or beds, desks, chairs, and dressers. Each floor has two community bathrooms with toilets, sinks, and shower stalls.

Included in Both Donaldson Brown and Main Campbell:

- A telephone with voicemail and local service in each room
- All utilities (water, electricity, heat) included in room rates
- Cable-access readiness in each room
- Ethernet connections for each resident
- Coin- or Hokie Passport-operated laundry machines
- Professional staff who assist residents with facility concerns, resources, and referrals
- Hall activities, including a hall council
- Social programs
- Mail rooms
- Study lounges*
- Community kitchens*

Beginning with the 2005-2006 academic year, graduate and professional student housing is being offered on campus in the Graduate Life Center at Donaldson Brown. Recently converted from a hotel and conference center, Donaldson Brown offers amenities available for the first time at Virginia Tech.

Community

With seminar and computer rooms, health and wellness resources, conferencing and reading space, a coffee shop, and more than one hundred students in residence, Donaldson Brown offers a peaceful, productive community for focused graduate and professional students. Donaldson Brown residents, who hail from various academic departments, can collaborate, network, and build contacts that will last throughout their professional lives.

Convenience

Located next door to the Newman Library, Squires Student Center, and on-campus dining centers, and steps away from academic buildings, downtown, and Blacksburg Transit/SmartWay bus stops, Donaldson Brown offers residents comfortable living without the need for a car.

Choice Amenities

The Center's spacious rooms are furnished with one queen, double, or twin bed in single rooms and two twin beds in double rooms, desks, chairs, and dressers or armoires. Each room features a private, tiled bathroom with a sink, toilet, and shower. Most bathrooms also include porcelain tubs. Every room boasts individual heating and air conditioning controls and plenty of room for student-supplied additional furniture and personal items. Most rooms are single-occupancy, but a limited number of double-occupancy rooms are available.

Linen service and small refrigerators can be contracted from other University sources for both Donaldson Brown and Main Campbell.

Availability

Rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis to students enrolled in the graduate school full time. Eligible students are offered housing concurrent with the start of an academic year, and as space occasionally becomes available. These facilities can accommodate individual men and women. At this time, Virginia Tech does not offer married or family housing. If you are a person with a disability and desire assistance or accommodation, please notify Student Programs at (540) 231-6207. If spaces for graduate students are not filled, they are offered to advanced undergraduates.

Dining Plans
